JUDGE HOGAN CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 10:00 A.M.

ITEM #1

THE COURT CONDUCTED A PUBLIC HEARING TO RECEIVE PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED COUNTY ROAD MAP, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 258, TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE. JUDGE HOGAN ASKED IF THERE WAS ANYONE PRESENT WHO WISHED TO PROTEST THE PROPOSED COUNTY ROAD MAP AT THIS TIME. MR. KENNETH BAKER WHO RESIDES AT 944 NORTH BEN PAYNE ROAD, ADDRESSED THE COURT CONCERNING ISSUES HE HAS WITH NORTH COUNTRY ROAD. MR. BAKER REQUESTED THAT THE COUNTY BARRICADE AN UNPAVED PORTION OF NORTH COUNTRY ROAD FROM PUBLIC ACCESS DUE TO VANDALISM, PUBLIC LEWDNESS, PUBLIC DUMPING AND BURNING DURING FIRE BANS. MR BAKER FURTHER STATED THAT HE RECEIVED CALLS FROM THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE INFORMING HIM THAT HIS FENCING WAS DOWN AND HIS CATTLE WERE LOOSE. THEY HAD BEEN TORN DOWN BY PEOPLE

MUDDING AND SLIDING INTO THEM. MR. BAKER URGED THE COURT TO BARRICADE THIS PORTION OF THE ROAD FOR THE SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC. JUDGE HOGAN ASKED IF THERE WAS ANYONE ELSE THAT WISHED TO ADDRESS THE COURT. NO ONE REQUESTED TO SPEAK.
