ITEM #1

COUNTY AUDITOR LISA CONSTANT EXPLAINED TO THE COURT THAT THERE NEEDED TO BE CLARIFICATION OF A PRIOR MOTION MADE BY THE COURT AS TO WHETHER THE JUVENILE SERVICES DEPARTMENT STAFF WERE TO BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT APPROVED IN THE FY2012 ANNUAL BUDGET. THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER MAGNESS, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER WIMPEE WITH THE COURT VOTING 5-0 IN FAVOR OF CLARIFYING THAT JUVENILE SERVICES EMPLOYEES WILL BE TREATED LIKE OTHER COUNTY EMPLOYEES WHEN IT COMES TO SALARIES.

JUDGE HOGAN DISCUSSED WITH THE COURT THE NEED FOR REPLACING THE CARPET IN THE HISTORICAL COURTHOUSE DUE TO DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE

FLOOD. THE MOTION WAS MADE BY JUDGE HOGAN, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER MAGNESS FOR DISCUSSION TO REPLACE THE GREEN CARPET IN THE HISTORIC COURTHOUSE WITH THE COLOR SPICE CURRENTLY INSTALLED IN THE COUNTY JUDGE'S OFFICE IN THE AREA OF THE COURTHOUSE NOT COVERED BY THE INSURANCE CLAIM AT A COST OF \$14,517.72 TO BE PAID FROM THE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS BUDGET. AFTER DISCUSSION THE MOTION PASSED WITH A 5-0 VOTE.
