JUDGE HOGAN GAVE THE COURT AN UPDATE ON THE COUNTY FINANCES FOR THE ROAD BOND PROJECT AND STATED THAT AT SOME POINT IN TIME TAXES WILL HAVE TO BE RAISED TO PAY FOR PAST, PRESENT AND FUTURE PROJECTS. HE ALSO ACKNOWLEDGED THAT THE SUCCESS OF THE

PROJECTS WAS DUE TO THE FORMATION OF THE CONSORTIUM SIX YEARS  
AGO. JUDGE HOGAN ALLOWED ATTENDEES THE OPPORTUNITY TO MAKE  
COMMENTS AND ASK QUESTIONS. THE GROUP WAS ENCOURAGED TO  
ADVISE THEIR CITIZENS OF HOW WELL THE COUNTY'S ROAD PROJECTS ARE  
COMING ALONG AND THAT THE ENTIRE PROGRAM IS GOING ACCORDING TO  
PLAN.
