JUDGE HOGAN CALLED THE WORKSHOP MEETING TO ORDER AT 3:00 P.M.

**1. PRESENTATION/DISCUSSION OF GRANT APPLICATION AND ROCKWALL
COUNTY MANAGED ASSIGNED COUNSEL AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
PROGRAM RESOLUTION, AND ALL RELATED ISSUES;**

COUNTY JUVENILE SERVICES DIRECTOR ANGIE SCALF PRESENTED THE COURT WITH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO ADDRESS THE MENTAL HEALTH NEEDS OF RESIDENTS IN ROCKWALL COUNTY. MS. SCALF EXPLAINED THE MANY CHALLENGES FACING THE COUNTY IN MEETING THESE NEEDS AND DISCUSSED WITH THE COURT A POSSIBLE SOLUTION, A GRANT OFFERED BY THE OFFICE OF INDIGENT DEFENSE. MS. SCALF RECOMMENDED THE COURT ENTER INTO THE GRANT AS A PILOT PARTICIPANT. THE COURT DISCUSSED AT LENGTH THE BENEFITS AND COSTS OF THE PROGRAM. EACH MEMBER OF THE COURT GAVE THEIR OPINIONS ON THE COUNTY PARTICIPATING IN THE

GRANT. LAKES REGIONAL MENTAL HEALTH MENTAL RETARDATION CENTER STATED THAT THE COST OF NOT PARTICIPATING COULD BE MORE COSTLY OVERALL THAN PARTICIPATING.
