Judge Hogan called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

1. Discussion of the new hire in the Maintenance Department in terms of skills required and salary level, and all related issues; (Hogan)

Maintenance Manager Luis Guzman addressed the Court and explained the current maintenance schedule of a typical day and discussed possible maintenance staffing needs with the Court. This item will be brought back to the Court for further discussion.

2. Discussion of the concept of a County representative being responsible for the management of all County vehicles with the exception of the Road and Bridge department, and all related issues; (Hogan)

The Court discussed asset management of County vehicles and setting uniform policies. Environmental Health Coordinator Ron Merritt will consider taking on this responsibility. County Auditor Lisa Constant Wylie offered her assistance for the administrative issues.

3. Discussion of replacing the washed out culvert on Troy Road, and all related issues; (Sevier-NeSmith)

Road and Bridge Director Pat NeSmith discussed with the Court and explained a problem in Precinct 1 with 120 feet of culvert pipe that is collapsing. Mr. NeSmith wanted to make the Court aware of the situation and recommended replacing it with concrete pipe. The Court discussed different options available to replace the pipe.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Announcements regarding County news, and upcoming County events.

Judge Hogan updated the Court on the progress being made with construction at the County Services Building. The Judge stated that the flags were at half-mast to recognize the terrorist shooting at the Naval Yard in Washington DC on September 16th.
