HEAD TO DISCUSS PERTINENT EVENTS AND ISSUES AFFECTING
THEIR OFFICES. THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT AND WISHED
TO SPEAK:

BRIAN CRENSHAW-INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DIRECTOR
STATED THAT HIS OFFICE HAD COMPLETELY MOVED TO THE
ANNEX, HE IS STARTING TO PLAN FOR THE BUDGET AND HE
WOULD LIKE TO CHANGE EMPLOYEE USER'S RIGHTS ON THE
COUNTY COMPUTER. COMMISSIONER BEATY REPORTED ABOUT
THE CURRENT HOUSE BILLS (HB 717, HB 1209 AND HB 2333) THAT

ROCKWALL COUNTY INDIGENT HEALTH CARE COORDINATOR DISCUSSED THE UPCOMING SEMINAR IN TYLER. RON MERRITT-HEALTH COORDINATOR REPORTED ON HIS WORK IN ROCKWALL LAKE ESTATES, PAUL MERRITT-ROAD AND BRIDGE ADMINISTRATOR STATED EVERYTHING WAS GOING FINE IN HIS DEPARTMENT. FELICIA MORRIS-COMMISSIONERS COURT COORDINATOR REMINDED EVERYONE TO CHECK WITH HER BEFORE TRYING TO USE THE HISTORIC COURTHOUSE BECAUSE OF THE UPCOMING ELECTIONS AND EARLY VOTING USE. LUIS GUZMAN-MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS DIRECTOR REPORTED IT DEPARTMENT MOVE TO THE COUNTY ANNEX BUILDING WAS COMPLETE. JOHN BLACKWOOD-COUNTY AUDITOR REMINDED THAT THE BUDGET PAPERS HAD BEEN SENT OUT TO ALL DEPARTMENTS AND THEY MUST BE RETURNED IN 45 DAYS TO HIS OFFICE. BILL SINCLAIR-COUNTY TREASURER REPORTED THE COUNTY BOND RATING WAS INCREASED BY MOODYS FROM A1 TO Aa3 AND BY S&P FROM A TO A+ BECAUSE OF THE CASH RESERVE, MOODYS RATES ONLY 7 COUNTIES THIS HIGH. KATHY MELSTON-LIBRARY DIRECTOR STATED THAT THE ANNUAL BOOK SALE WILL BE THIS WEEKEND AT THE HARRY MYERS COMMUNITY CENTER, ALL PROCEEDS WILL HELP FUND THE SUMMER READING. WESLEY ROBERTS-COUNTY FIRE MARSHAL STATED THAT HIS MOVE TO THE ANNEX WAS COMPLETE. COMMISSIONER GRINNAN

REMINDED EVERYONE OF THE PRESENTATION AT THE REPUBLICAN WOMEN'S MEETING ON APRIL 19, 2007. GLENDA DENTON-ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR SPOKE ABOUT THE UPCOMING ELECTIONS. LISA CONSTANT-COUNTY CLERK REPORTED THE LATEST INFORMATION ON THE REDACTION ISSUES. KAY MCDANIEL-DISTRICT CLERK ALSO SPOKE ABOUT REDACTION ISSUES. SHERIFF EAVENSON ALSO SPOKE OF THE PRESENTATION THAT HE WOULD BE GIVING ON APRIL 19TH AND ALSO THE NEED FOR BETTER SOFTWARE FOR HIS DEPARTMENT.
