- DISCUSSION OF REYAS LAND DEVELOPMENT ISSUES: RON MERRITT, COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH COORDINATOR BROUGHT THIS SUBJECT TO THE COURT AFTER A SEPTIC PERMIT WAS REQUESTED BY THE FAMILY. THREE HOME SITES ON THE PROPERTY ARE OWNED BY ONE FAMILY AND THEY ALL SHARE THE SAME DRIVEWAY. CURRENTLY THE SITE DOES NOT VIOLATE ANY COUNTY REGULATIONS BUT IF THE FAMILY TRIED TO SELL THE PROPERTY THEN SEPARATE DRIVEWAYS WOULD BE REQUIRED.
