All remarks and questions addressed to the Board shall be addressed to the Board as a whole and not to any individual member thereof;

 - 5. Engineering matters, including:
 - a) Design;
 - b) Approve construction plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids;
 - c) Review bids and award contracts;
 - d) Approve pay estimates, change orders and final acceptance and direct Engineer to notify insurance company of new facilities;
 - e) Accept certificates of completion and authorize final acceptance of facilities, if necessary;
 - f) Deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters; and
 - g) Authorize and/or ratify repair and maintenance of District facilities, as necessary.
 - 6. Review and approval of Bookkeeper's report, payment of invoices, review and approve any revised or amended operating budget, and take any other action appropriate in connection with District accounts;
