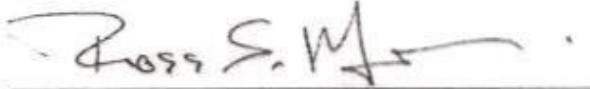

1. Call to order;
2. Public communications and comments;
3. Review and approve Minutes of July 16, 2024 Board of Directors Meeting;
4. Confirm receipt of 2024 certified tax roll prepared by Rockwall Central Appraisal District, consider authorizing tax rate calculation services; adopt resolution;
5. Review tax rate recommendation, approve proposed tax rate for 2024, adopt Notice of Water District Hearing on Tax Rate, and authorize publication;
6. Hear engineer's report, including authorization of advertisements for construction of District improvement projects, award construction contracts, approve pay estimates and/or change orders related to on-going projects, approval and acceptance of final projects and conveyances related to such projects and take any action necessary or related thereto;
7. Hear report from developer and take any action in connection with plat approval, reimbursement agreements, or assignments thereunder;
8. Review and approve bookkeeping and tax collection reports, and take any action on bookkeeping related matters including quarterly investment reports; investment recommendations; new account related matters; updated list of designated banks; revisions to engagement letter for bookkeeping services; and authorize release of checks as noted on report;
9. Discuss correspondence from City of Fate regarding District's regular Board meeting schedule, and take any action as may be necessary;
10. Discuss tentative date for next meeting; and
11. Adjournment.
