<sup>\*</sup>The District levies taxes in accordance with the Texas Water Code. The District's current operations and maintenance tax rate is equal to \$0.43 per \$100 of assessed value. Average homestead values are determined by the county appraisal district. All estimates above were prepared utilizing the average resident homestead value as of the time that the District's most recent Truth in Taxation worksheet was prepared in accordance with the Texas Water Code.

DISCLAIMER: This statement is prepared pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.043(c) as amended by House Bill 1522, 89th regular session. This District has used Texas Water Code equivalent calculations in place of the Tax Code, Chapter 26 "no-new-revenue tax rate" referenced in HB 1522 and has used average the homestead value as required by Texas Water Code Section 49.236 rather than the median homestead values specified in HB 1522. These modifications are necessary because the referenced Tax Code provisions do not apply to the District.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Average tax bill estimates for the current and proposed budgets reflect those taxes necessary to fund the operations and maintenance tax revenues stated in the applicable budget.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>This column estimates the operations and maintenance taxes to be paid on the average homestead if the proposed budget generates the same amount of operations and maintenance tax revenues as the current budget.
