HOW TO SET UP AN ELECTRONIC BOOKS OR AN eAUDIOBOOK ACCOUNT

- 1. From a public PC in the Library, go to www.rockwallcountytexas.com/library
- 2. Choose "Databases and Downloads" from the left-hand side.
- 3. Choose "Downloadable Audio and Visual eBooks."
- 4. You will see text that reads:

A selection of visual eBooks to be viewed on your computer can be downloaded from EBSCOHost.

Downloadable audio books from Recorded Books are temporarily available here.



- 5. Choose the colored text that matches what you are looking for.
- 6. On the EBSCOhost screen, click on "Sign in" in the upper right-hand corner.
- 7. Then click on "Create a New Account" in the upper right-hand corner.
- 8. You will need to create an account even if you previously had a netlibrary.com account. Make up a user name and password that you will remember. Write them down and keep them, as the library staff has no access to these. Your username must be unique, so your choice may be rejected if someone else is using it already. Your password must be at least 6 characters long.
- 9. All fields are required for the successful account set-up including a personal e-mail address.



- 10. You will see a logo like this telling you that you are logged in.
- 11. You will not be able to DOWNLOAD eAudiobook or eBook FILES TO THE LIBRARY COMPUTERS.
